

THE CO-OPERATIVE HUNTERS CONTEST IS INTENDED FOR RESIDENTS OF NORTHWEST TERRITORIES AND NUNAVUT ONLY AND IS GOVERNED BY CANADIAN LAW

1. **How to Enter** – No purchase necessary. Contestants can enter by submitting their name at their local Co-op (the “Co-op”) for each set of draws. The contest starts at 9:00 AM local time, March 1, 2021. Selected contestants will be required to first correctly answer a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question without mechanical aid before being declared a winner.
2. **Prizes** – There are two (2) prizes of \$250 worth of hunting supplies from the local Co-op, selected by the chosen contestant, available to be won at each draw. There will be three (3) draws during the year, for a total of six (6) prizes valued at \$250 each. The Co-op reserves the right to make prize substitutions of equivalent value in the event of unavailability of the prizes or any aspect thereof for reasons beyond the control of the Co-op. The prizes must be accepted as awarded without substitution, cannot be transferred and are not convertible to cash. Selected contestants are encouraged to take pictures while out on the land using the hunting supplies purchased with the Prize and send such pictures to the Co-op.
3. **Selection of Winners** – The first two (2) winners will be selected from all eligible entries received, in a random draw by the Co-op at the local Co-op store on or about the last week of May 2021. The second two (2) winners will be selected from all eligible entries received between June 1, 2021 and on or about August 31, 2021 in a random draw by the Co-op at the local Co-op store on or about the first week of September 2021. The final two (2) winners will be selected from all eligible entries received between September 1, 2021 and on or about October 31, 2021, in a random draw by the Co-op at the local Co-op store on or about the first week of November 2021. Winners will be contacted by the local Co-op by phone or in person. If he or she is unable to be reached in that manner, or if a response is not received, within 48 hours of the draw, he or she will forfeit their prize and another eligible entry will be drawn. All prizes will be hand delivered to or picked up in person by the confirmed winners. The Co-op shall not be responsible for any prizes lost, stolen or damaged.
4. **Contest Closing Date** - The contest will close on October 31, 2021.
5. **Contest Eligibility** - Entrants must be 16 years of age or older and a resident of Nunavut or Northwest Territories to participate in this contest. Employees and volunteers of the Co-op *are eligible* to win this contest. One individual can win one (1) prize in all draws.
6. **Chances of Winning** - The chances of winning a prize will depend on the total number of eligible entries received before the contest closing date in accordance with these rules.
7. **Release and Waiver** - Winners may be required to complete, sign, and return a declaration, release and waiver of liability in the form provided by the Co-op within the time specified by the Co-op, and must have abided by the contest rules. Failure to return the duly completed declaration, release and waiver form, if required, within the time stipulated or failure to abide by these rules will result in disqualification and another entry will be randomly selected from the remaining eligible entries.
8. **Decisions Final** - By entering the contest, entrants agree to be bound by these contest rules and agree that all decisions made by the Co-op with respect to all aspects of this contest are final and not subject to challenge. These rules may be amended at any time by the Co-op without notice. The Co-op expressly reserves the right to take any steps it deems necessary in its absolute discretion, including the limiting of entries and the exclusion of entrants, in order to ensure that the contest is conducted in a fair way for all entrants and for the Co-op.
9. **No Liability** – In addition to the other limitation of liability clauses contained in these rules, the local Co-op, Arctic Co-operatives Limited and their respective employees, agents, representatives, promotional agencies and assignees shall not be responsible in any way for loss or damage arising from the use of or, bear any liability whatsoever in any way attributable to, the prizes awarded in this contest, or with items purchased with the prizes awarded in this contest, or the entry by any entrant herein. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the local Co-op assumes no responsibility or liability for any risk associated with the acceptance or use of the prizes awarded as part of this contest.
10. **Entries belong to The Co-op** - All entries become the property of the Co-op and will not be returned.
11. **Lost Entries** - The Co-op is not responsible for any lost, misdirected, illegible, incomplete or delayed entries.
12. **Consent to Use and Personal Information** - By entering the contest, entrants consent to the use and publication of their name, photograph, voice or statements in connection with the contest or any subsequent similar contest held by the Co-op or for any other promotion, without payment or compensation other than the chance to win the prize awarded. The personal information obtained from the contest entry form will not be used or disclosed by The Co-op for any purpose other than general contest administration and the purposes set forth herein.
13. **Applicable Laws** - This contest is subject to all applicable, federal, provincial/territorial and municipal laws and regulations.

14. **Cancellations, Suspensions or Modifications** - The Co-op may, in its discretion, cancel, suspend or modify this contest, without liability to anyone whatsoever. If this is an online contest and for any reason the online portion is not capable of being completed as planned, including but not limited to computer lines, bugs, tampering, technical failures or other causes beyond its control, the Co-op reserves the right to cancel, suspend or modify the online portion of the contest.
15. **Email Addresses** - In the event of a dispute as to the identity of a winner based on an email address, the winning entry will be deemed to be made by the person who was assigned the email address by an internet service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the email address in question at the time of entry.
16. **Errors and Omissions Excepted** - The Co-op is not responsible for any errors whatsoever in these contest rules or promotion of the contest, including without limitation any printing, distribution or production errors and may, in its discretion, withdraw this contest if it is found to contain any such error, without liability to anyone whatsoever.
